1. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

With reference to the above GeM Bid, the following amendments are hereby issued:

1. Amendment in Buyer Uploaded Additional Terms & Conditions (ATC)

The Buyer Uploaded Additional Terms & Conditions (ATC) shall stand amended as under:

Overall basis on the net landed value	Item-wise basis on the net landed value

Accordingly, the evaluation of bids shall be carried out on an **item-wise basis on the net landed value** in line with the evaluation methodology specified in the GeM Bid.

2. Extension of Tender Opening Date

The Tender Opening Date of the above GeM Bid is hereby extended by **Five (05) days**. The revised date shall be as reflected on the GeM portal.

All other terms and conditions of the GeM Bid, including the Buyer Uploaded Additional Terms & Conditions (ATC), shall remain **unchanged**.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Offers of only those participating parties will be considered for bid opening/ evaluation who meets the following eligibility criteria:

Otherwise, it is compulsory to submit the financial details of the immediate three preceding financial years. (Example, In case, audited annual report of immediate preceding financial year (year ending 31st March) is not available and where enquiry issue date is up to 31st December, the financial details of the three previous years immediately prior to the last financial year may be submitted. However, in case the enquiry issue date is after 31st December, it is compulsory to submit the financial details of the immediate three preceding financial years only.)

The Buyer ,is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequent thereof including any restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and including the modification of the specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. All representations / grievances pertaining to the ATC shall be raised with the buyer organization directly and not with GeM. If any of the clause(s) is/are incorporated by the bidder regarding the following, the bid & resultant contract shall be treated as null & void. Further, GeM reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to cancel the bid forthwith, without issuance of any prior notice or intimation :-

1. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available (unless such Custom / item is bunched with the major regular product Category Item).
2. Mandating procurement of / from specific Brand / Make / Model / Manufacturer / Dealer except in case of Single Proprietary Article Certificate (PAC) Buying.
3. Inclusion of disqualification criteria related to suspension of seller / service provider, where such suspension period has already expired.
4. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
5. Publishing bids on GeM for procurement of works.
6. Procurement of Goods by creating a Service bid on GeM & vice-versa.
7. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. However, trial / sample, as the case may be, shall be permitted in cases where trial / sample are allowed as per approved and published procurement policy of the Buyers' controlling Ministry / Department / State / Public Sector Enterprises Headquarters. If there is a violation of trial / sample clause with regard to approved policy of the Buyers' Ministry / Department / State / Sector Enterprises Headquarters, then this is to be determined and redressed by the concerned Buyer Organization only.

9. Creating bid for items from incorrect categories.
10. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
11. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee, as the case may be.
12. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined in bid detail section, including specific EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by applicable GeM GTC.
13. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii) (h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders for a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.
14. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added, additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogues or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, he can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field on the dashboard after logging in as a seller. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
