TECHNICAL EVALUATION:

- Offers of all the prospective tenderes will be evaluated considering 'Eligibility Criteria', Refer ANNEXURE-III.
- All Offers have to conform to Technical specifications mentioned in List of Items & Technical Specifications (Annexure-I).
- Technical bids of all participating tenderes shall be evaluated considering both Eligibility Criteria and Technical specifications mentioned in List Of items & Technical Specifications (Annexure-I) of NIT.

PRICE EVALUATION:

- Price bids of only those tenderes shall be opened who qualifies Technical bid evaluation as mentioned above and based on the following:
- Evaluation of bids shall be done on landed value at RFCL site, Ramagundam basis including GST, Packing & Forwarding, Insurance & Freight and all charges leviable to RFCL upto RFCL site. RFCL at its sole discretion may vary quantities, if so, required at the time of PO placement.
- The benefit due to set-off of GST if any, shall be taken by RFCL and the same shall not be considered while evaluation of bids.

8 Packing & Forwarding:

Material should be packed under packing of 45 Kg or 50 Kg HDPE Bags. Special handling Instructions (If any) should be mentioned in the consignment note.

9 Deliveries/Despatches:

Timely Supply will be considered as the essence of the purchase order. The actual date of successful supply of the <u>"TECHNICAL GRADE UREA"</u> at the consignee's place will be considered as the date of Completion, as the terms of the Purchase Order are on F.O.R. destination basis.

If the delivery of <u>"TECHNICAL GRADE UREA"</u> is delayed by the successful tenderer beyond 15 days from date(s) stipulated, RFCL can also notify the concerned successful tenderer by email, followed by a letter that the goods have not been delivered. RFCL shall there upon have the right to exercise the following option, seven days after such email intimation of default to the concerned successful tenderer:



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"To treat the default as a breach of contract and to terminate the contract forthwith forfeiting EMD & security deposit and taking other action against the tenderer within the provisions of the contract."

10 Pre -Dispatch Inspection/ Rejection of supplies after testing at RFCL Laboratory:

10.1 Vendor shall perform tests and inspection necessary to ensure that the material conform to the requirement of this specification and submit the Pre-delivery inspection report to RFCL before dispatching the "TECHNICAL GRADE UREA", not conforming to specifications shall be rejected by RFCL and shall be replaced by the supplierS immediately after intimation within 10 days to supply the replacement.

The rejected "<u>TECHNICAL GRADE UREA</u>" which shall lie with RFCL at the risk and cost of the suppliers and removed by supplier within 15 days from the date of notification of rejection, failing which RFCL shall have the right to exercise one or more of the following options:

- (i) To return the rejected "<u>TECHNICAL GRADE UREA</u>" on "freight to pay" basis at suppliers' risk and cost and to recover the cost against payment to be made to supplier available with RFCL and / or invoking the BG of Security Deposit.
- (ii) To dispose of such "<u>TECHNICAL GRADE UREA</u>" at the supplier's risk, cost, and the suppliers in such cases shall be deemed to have not supplied the rejected quantity of "<u>TECHNICAL GRADE UREA</u>" and shall be liable to the penalty in terms of the contract.
- 10.2 If any supplier again supplies sub-standard "<u>TECHNICAL GRADE UREA</u>" (Against replacement of Rejected item), they would be liable to be delisted and debarred from participating in future tenders of RFCL. If debarred the suppliers would be notified of the same.

10.3 WEIGHMENT

The requisite Technical Grade Urea as per NIT specification, Annexure-I are sought in packing of 45/50 Kg HDPE Bags. The bags will be weighed at RFCL, Ramagundam to ascertain the quantity of supplies.

11 Payment TERMS:

Offer validity of the Tender shall be valid minimum 120 days from the date of tender opening.
- The Tenderer shall quote the price strictly in prescribed RFCL's Price bid format only.  - Chief Presidency Magistrate / Additional Chief Presidency Magistrate / Presidency Magistrate
 - Revenue Officer not below the rank of Tehsildar
 - Sub-Divisional Officer of the area where the individual and/or his family normally resides.
- iii. The registration shall be valid as on date of placement of order. A self-attested photocopy of the relevant certificate shall be submitted as a support document.
